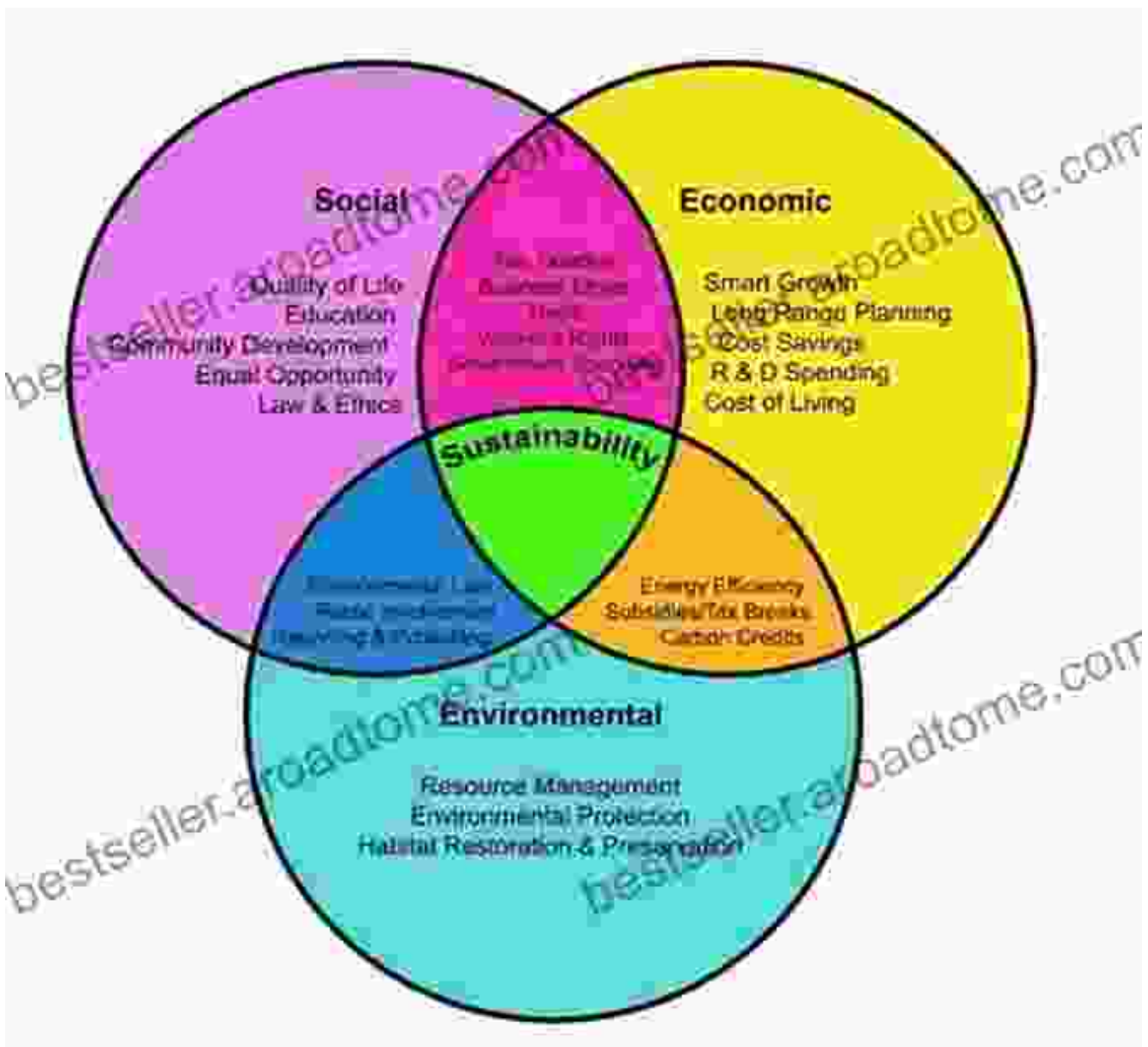


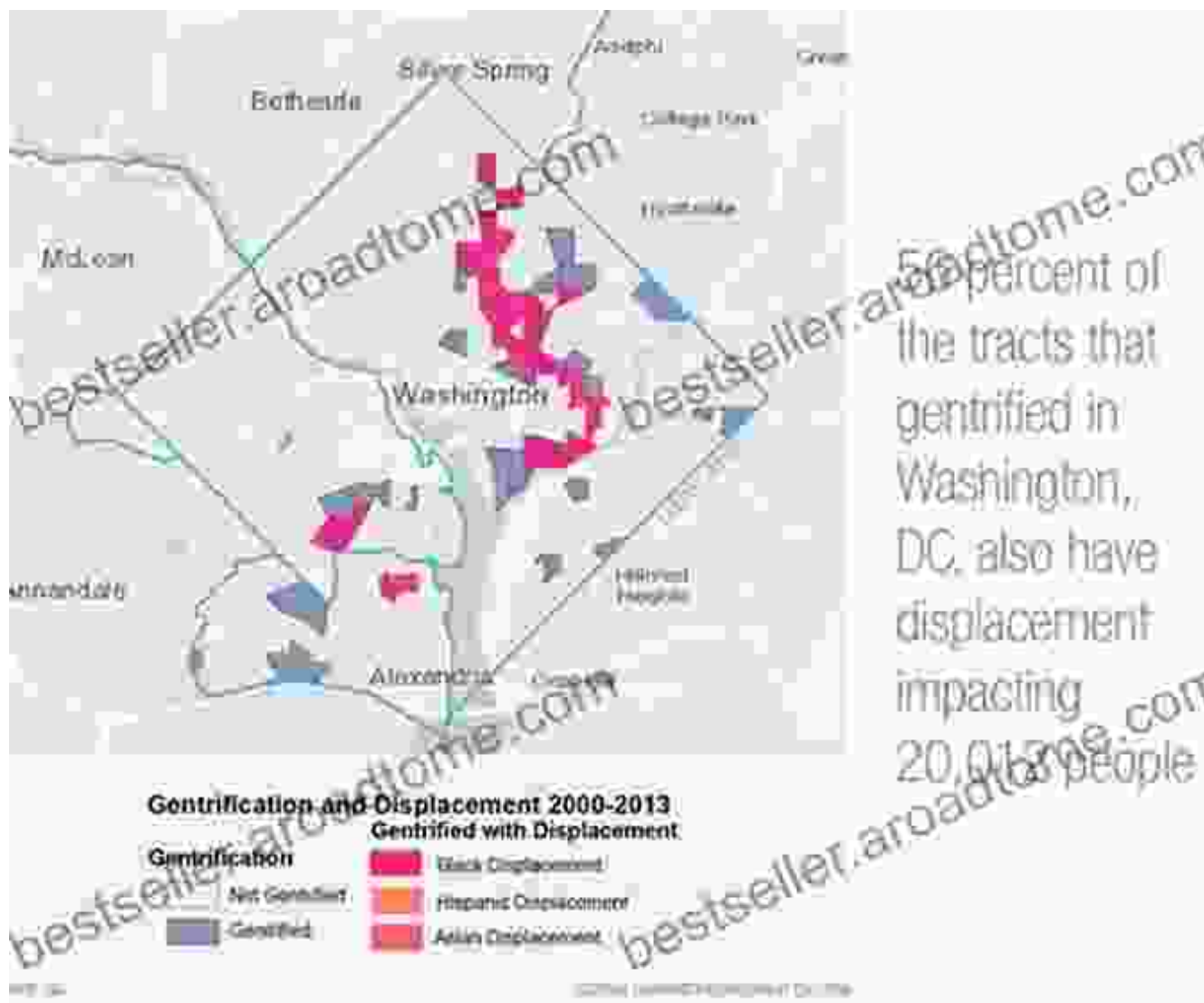
Figure 2: The Built Environment as a Reflection of Social Inequality

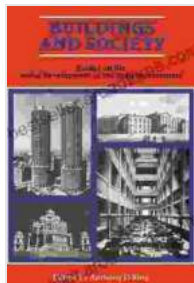
