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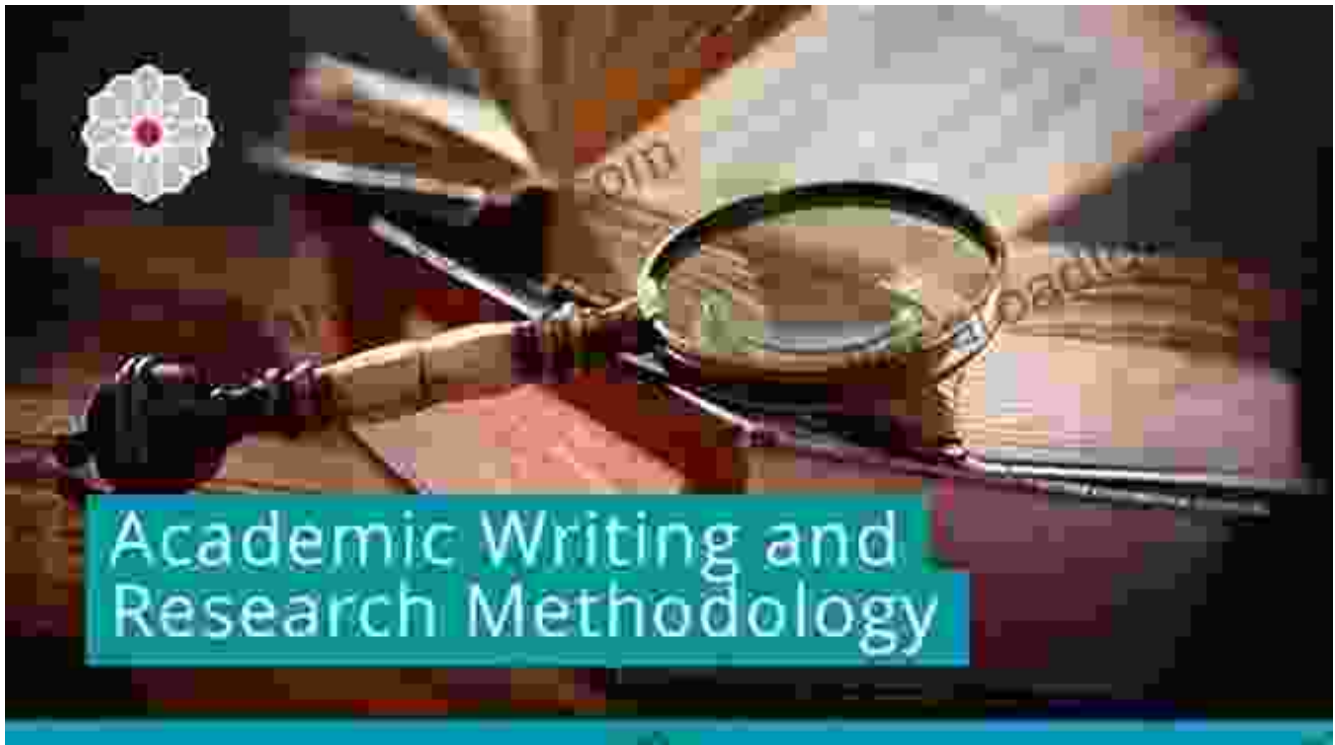

4	<u>Topic 3</u> -state your points/arguments -explore both sides of debate (in a better answer)
5	<u>Conclusion</u> (only if you have time) -wrap up your points in essay -you can offer your own personal opinion on essay question if time

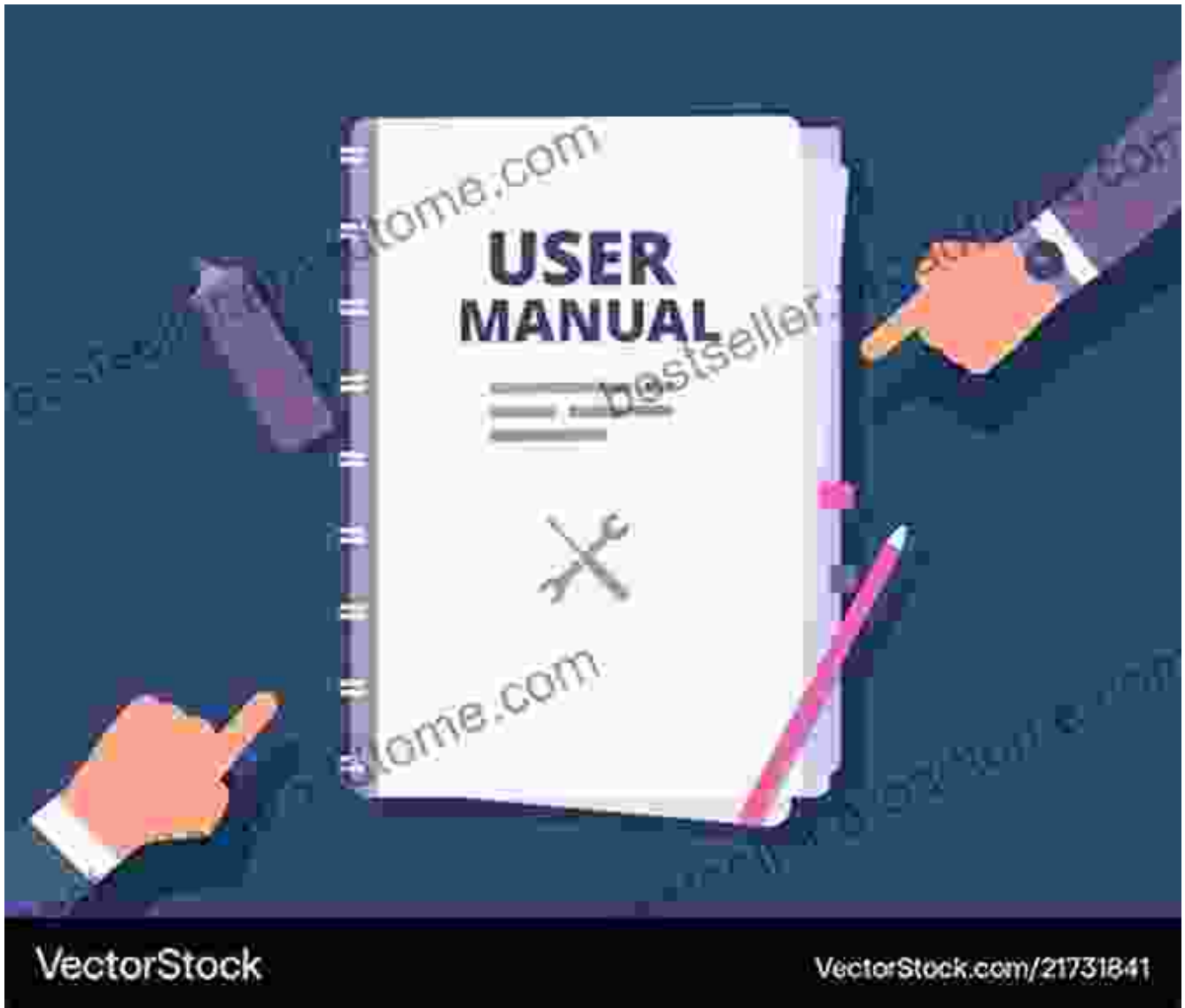

← No parentheses and no page number and also note that the Author's last name goes first followed by first name.

- More than One Citation from a Source:

– Rashid, Taliban, 26. [Or the appropriate use of Ibid. or ibid., 26.]

- Follow the appropriate style guidance (Chicago Manual or other) for

– Magazine articles, Internet or on-line sources, government publications, etc.

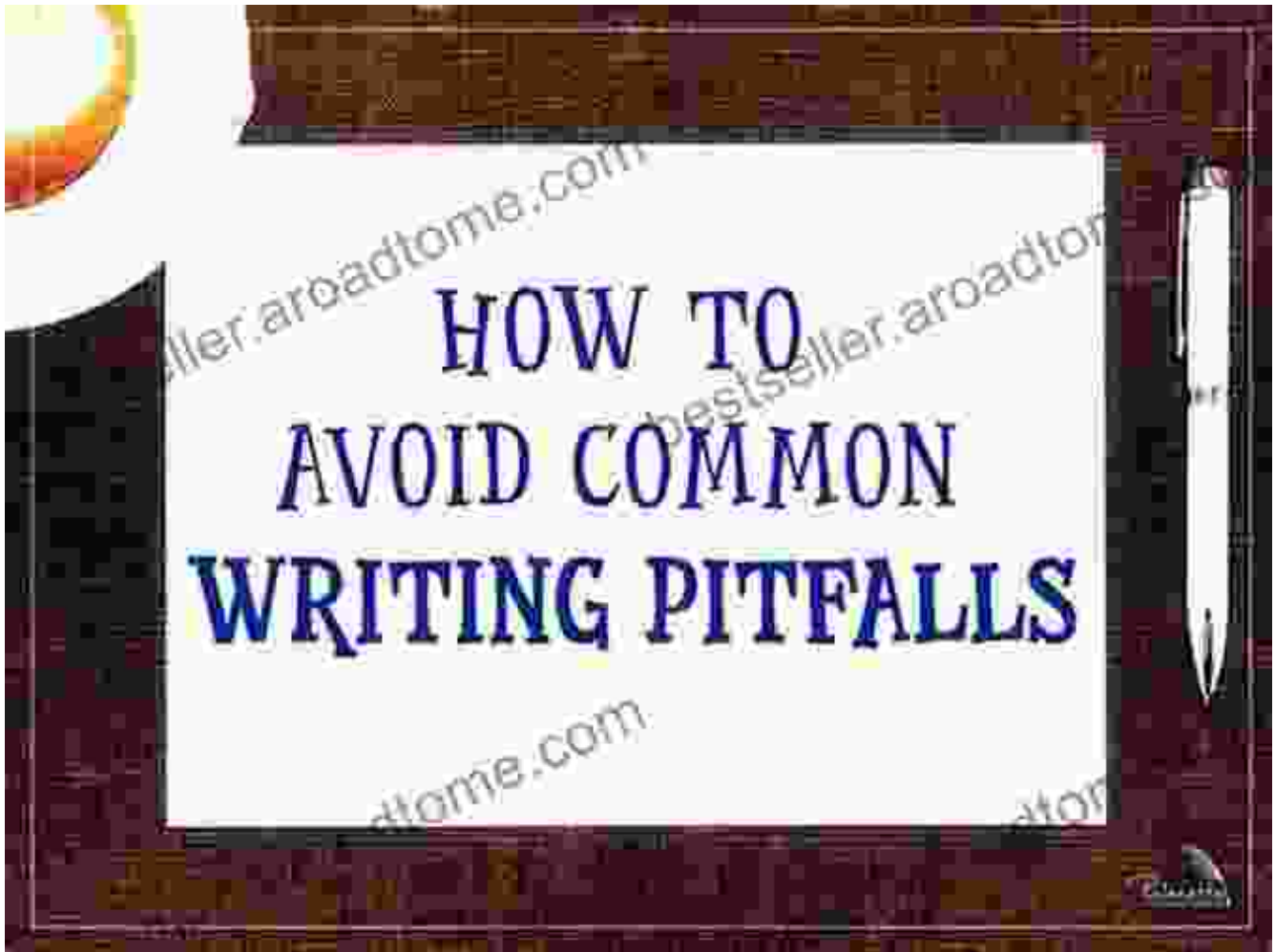

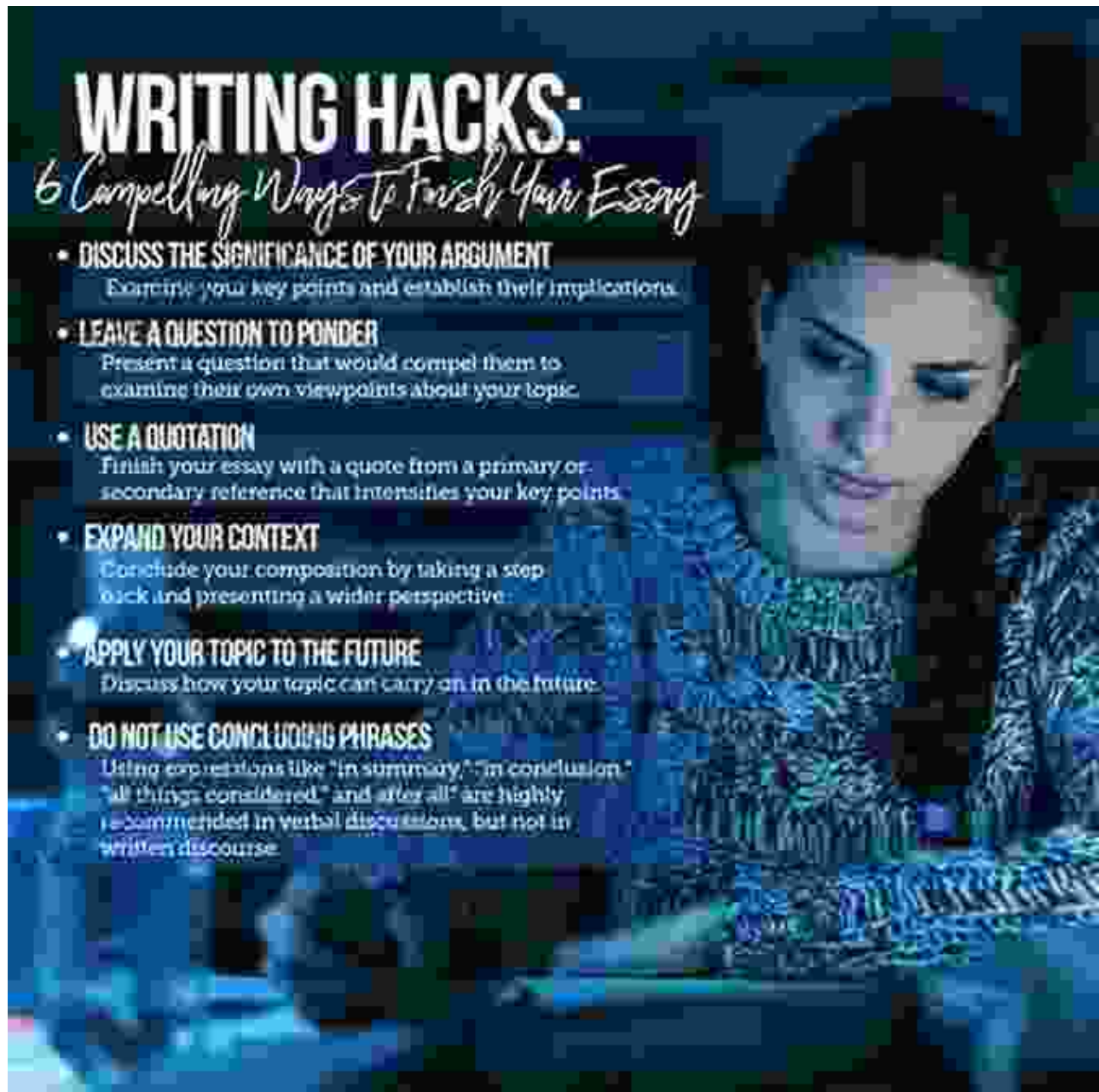

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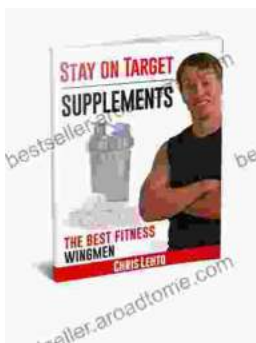
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
